

Factors and Impact of the Crime of Adultery on Family Unity and Children's Future

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ABSTRACT

This research aims to determine the causal factors and efforts to overcome the crime of adultery so that they can be taken into consideration by someone who is planning to commit the crime of adultery. This research is important because regulations regarding adultery are not yet a solution to prevent adultery, so this research was carried out to find out the criminological causal factors and find out prevention efforts. This research uses normative empirical methods, data collection was carried out through direct interviews with the Bandar Lampung police station to obtain data on crimes of adultery. This is because this research examines legal norms relating to adultery as a social "parasite". The results of the research show that law enforcement and non-penal measures have not had a deterrent effect on perpetrators of adultery, so regulations regarding the crime of adultery must be updated by increasing the number of penalties for perpetrators and closing locations that have the potential to become places of adultery.

INTRODUCTION

In essence, harmonization in married life is really needed, especially in establishing a relationship with a husband and wife who are bound by marriage. A harmonious marriage is a marriage that is built on a sense of mutual trust because one partner is busy or even both are busy with work or other matters, causing the two to rarely meet and communicate, namely maintaining trust is the main task. (Ahmad Atabik and Khoridatul Mudhiiah 2016)

In general, according to Article 33 and Article 34 of Law Number 1 of 1974 concerning Marriage as amended by Law No. 16 of 2019 (hereinafter referred to as the Marriage Law), husband and wife are obliged to be loyal and love each other, respect each other, and give each other help physically and mentally. The husband is obliged to protect and fulfill household necessities according to his ability, while the wife is obliged to manage household affairs as well as possible. (Syaiful Anwar 2021)

Based on this explanation, husband and wife must take care of each other so that the household can grow in harmony and not duplicate each other so that a good family and offspring are created to prepare the nation's next generation who are ready with a golden generation for the progress of the Indonesian state because a good generation of nation administrators is every growth and development is maintained and in a supportive environment. However, there will always be problems in the household, one of which is the husband or wife's adultery with someone else. (Dhea Sukma Putri 2022)

Adultery is an act that can damage the foundations of a nation's morality. Article 284 of the Criminal Code regulates and explains that adultery is classified as adultery, namely sexual intercourse between unmarried couples, where one or both parties are still bound by marriage to another person. So it can be understood that if there is a couple who is not married and has had sexual relations outside of legal marriage, then the act that has been carried out cannot be prosecuted by law and cannot be classified as adultery.

The act of zina or mukah, according to Article 284 of the Criminal Code, is sexual relations or sexual intercourse outside of marriage committed by a man and a woman, both or one of whom is still married to another person. This act of adultery is of course a big problem and is even the main cause of the collapse of households. The victims of adultery, whether husband or wife, did not accept this disgraceful act. This is proven by the occurrence of this. Not a few victims of the impact of adultery asked for divorce because they felt betrayed and second-guessed.

The crime of adultery itself is a violation of criminal law which violates the provisions of the Article on Adultery, namely Article 284 of the Criminal Code which states that if a husband or wife has sexual relations with another person, they will be subject to a sentence of 9 months, this applies if there is a complaint from the husband, or his wife.

According to the Criminal Code, adultery is identified with overspel which has a much narrower meaning than adultery itself. The Criminal Code prohibits the crime of adultery because adultery is considered a sinful act that

can be committed by both men and women and is considered an insult to the sacred covenant of marriage. Therefore, the Criminal Code prohibits the crime of adultery.

Nowadays, in marriages, there are cases of adultery involving both the husband and the wife. However, in fact, what often happens in Indonesia is that the majority of the perpetrators of adultery are the husband. There are 18,678 adultery cases in Indonesia that have been recorded. The phenomenon of adultery in Indonesia with that many cases is no longer something that should be left alone, the causes of these cases must be looked for so that cases of adultery in Indonesia can decrease. Source directory of supreme court decisions. (Direktori Putusan 2023)

The author can present an example of a crime of adultery in the following case example:

- 1) Jakarta - The woman who went viral on social media after telling about the behavior of her biological mother and ex-husband, Norma Risma, officially reported the two of them to the Banten Regional Police on suspicion of adultery. "According to the report, it is ready," said the Hotman Paris Official 911 Team, Zahra Amelia, Monday (30/1/2023). The Police Report (LP) has been received by the Ditreskrim Polda Banten with number LP/B/19/I/2023/SPKT II.DITRESKRIMUM/POLDA BANTEN, with Article 284 of the Criminal Code concerning adultery. (Yandhi Deslamata 2023)

This research requires chrominological analysis in dealing with these cases, including revealing the factors that cause crimes. And the impact of losses arising from crime. In the end, criminology only recommends how to prevent or overcome it. The recommendations presented are complex and very broad.

The aim of this research is to find out what are the factors behind the occurrence of adultery and the negative impacts that occur when committing the crime of adultery, especially on the integrity of the family and the future of the child. Because by preventing and limiting yourself from a crime you will keep yourself away from criminal acts or crime. Based on previous research, it explains the wider impact, namely the impact on society, while this research focuses on the impact on the family and the child's future, therefore this research is substantially new.

THEORETICAL REVIEW

Cases of adultery crimes from the perspective of criminology can be analyzed from various criminological theories. In this writing the author will use criminological theory, namely: Differential Association Theory (Sutherland), Anomie Theory, Culture Conflict Theory, Control Theory, Labeling Theory. Apart from using criminological theory, the author will also use the theory of crime prevention and these efforts, namely penal efforts and non-penal efforts. Penal efforts are efforts that are based on statutory regulations and other rules that have been determined by existing legal regulations, meaning that penal efforts are through legal channels, while non-penal efforts are more focused on preventive action before a criminal act occurs,

meaning non-penal efforts are through external efforts law. (Emilia Susanti and Eko Rahardjo 2018)

METHODOLOGY

This research uses normative empirical research methods, namely conducting direct interviews with the Bandar Lampung police station to obtain data and information regarding the crime of adultery, including the causes, impacts and prevention efforts. Then the author also applies a descriptive analysis approach to managing qualitative data along with a deductive method in concluding problems. This method was carried out so that the discovery of the value of this research obtains relevant data and research that occurs in social communities.

Then, normatively, the author refers to applicable regulations and literature studies, namely the approach to statutory regulations sourced from primary data, namely Law No. 1 of 2023 concerning the Criminal Code (national), the Marriage Law and several regulations under it, as well as literature study sourced from secondary materials in the form of books, journals and other legal materials. The data analysis carried out was qualitative analysis, which was carried out to describe realities based on research results in the form of explanations that could not be realized in numerical form. Then, from the data analysis, we continue to draw inductive conclusions.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Factors Behind the Occurrence of Adultery

Before explaining the results of the research and discussion, we will first explain the number of cases of adultery crimes. Based on data obtained by the author from the Bandar Lampung City Police, there were several cases of adultery crimes in Bandar Lampung. Agus Riyanto said that throughout 2023 there would be 8 reports regarding adultery cases, of which many cases were later withdrawn by the reporter.

According to the Law, marriage is a physical and spiritual bond between a man and a woman as husband and wife with the aim of forming a happy and eternal family (household) based on the belief in the Almighty God. Families should be built with harmony and without any adultery in them, but in reality there are still husbands or wives who commit the crime of adultery.

One example of a case that occurred in Lampung on Tuesday 29 October 2019 at around 22.30 WIT or at least in October 2019, took place in a boarding house on Jalan Panorama Sukarame Bandar Lampung Bandar Lampung or at least somewhere in the area Tanjungkarang District Court law, married A.C on Friday 18 January 2013 based on Marriage Certificate Excerpt Number: 148/09/II/2013, committed adultery with BE who was married to YC on Monday 21 June 2010 based on Excerpt Marriage Deed Number: 210/53/VI/2010., States that the Defendant has been legally and convincingly proven guilty of committing the crime of "Adultery" as stated in the single indictment of the Public Prosecutor and sentences the Defendant to imprisonment for 3 (three) months.

Based on the data in the table, this case figure is certainly not the final figure regarding the number of cases of adultery crimes that occurred in Bandar Lampung City, adultery is a private matter for the community, in fact many cases of adultery are not reported, so based on this data the author analyzes that those who dare Just report there is more than one case and then there are definitely more cases of unreported adultery than that. Adultery is one of the criminal acts against adultery which is increasing over time, therefore, according to the author, various efforts are made to prevent it from happening. Prevention of adultery must be carried out immediately with the support of related parties such as the government and legal entities involved in it so that prevention of adultery is truly resolved properly.

Cases of adultery crimes from the perspective of criminology can be analyzed from various criminological theories. In this writing the author will use criminological theory, namely:

The following will explain in detail the factors that cause adultery.

Differential Association Theory or environmental factors, Differential Association Theory is a theory that studies individual behavior which is influenced by certain people who are associated with that individual. A person's behavior can be influenced by the environment in which the person lives and a person's interactions in their environment greatly influence a person's behavior and personality.

Cases of adultery can occur in environments where social disorganization is relatively high and also contribute to causing adultery, especially in prostitution locations. People who live and grow up in the area consider prostitution to be normal. In this situation, it does not mean that we condone adultery, but it is important for stakeholders to have the ability to detect as early as possible the environments that lead to this deviant situation so that it can be prevented.

Environmental and social influences greatly influence a person to commit the crime of adultery. The perpetrator tends not to be able to control his interactions with his peers. This greatly influences the perpetrator to commit the crime of adultery and imitate the behavior of his environment. Perpetrators in the same social circle will have an influence on someone who commits a crime. This is what is done by perpetrators of the crime of adultery, because there is an invitation from their environment to commit a crime, which influences someone to do the same thing regardless of the sanctions that will be given.

A crime will certainly have a bad impact, especially the crime of adultery. The bad impact will be felt not only by the perpetrator but also by the people around him, one of whom is the family and children of the perpetrator of the adultery. Below we will explain the negative impacts of the crime of adultery in detail.

Anomie theory, economic factors Anomie theory is a situation that exists without social norms and without direction so that the life that is carried out is not in harmony with reality. As a result, various tensions in the structure of society make a person experience stress or tension, resulting in anomie behavior. Economic factors can influence a person to commit crime and can even be the main factor. With economic conditions that are not met in the family and the perpetrator finds someone who is more financially capable so that he can help the perpetrator in meeting his economic needs, he will feel comfortable and turn to someone whose economic needs are indeed met.

Economic factors can also be a factor in someone committing adultery, in fact there were many cases of adultery that occurred in 2020, which was the Covid-19 period which had a big impact on the economic decline, and that is where many cases of adultery and divorce occurred, people who experiencing the economic downturn, he felt that there was no longer any happiness in his household.

the existence of economic motives can also be the cause of adultery in the household, by carrying out this behavior, economic benefits can be obtained, for example the emergence of the sugar daddy/sugar mommy phenomenon. which means that because the perpetrator's economy is not fulfilled, he looks for someone to fulfill his economic needs, this is done without thinking about the impact that will occur after committing adultery, he can even sacrifice everything to be able to fulfill his economic needs in this wrong way.

Culture Conflict Theory or Cultural Deviation is a theory that explains that the root cause of crime or crimes is due to clashes in values between cultural groups due to differences in behavior that is considered appropriate in social life. Culture Conflict is behavior that arises because of other cultures that influence them to have this behavior, which cannot be separated from the crime of adultery. that cultural deviations also influence the existence of cultural differences between the husband or wife, because it is possible that the differences in the culture of each individual or their customs can cause debates regarding something, so that quarrels occur and the household is not harmonious so that the perpetrator looks for pleasure outside the home.

According to him, you can have the same culture as him so that you can communicate and always agree on everything. However, this cannot be justified because in reality households are built with differences so that these differences can be communicated so that an agreement can be decided between the two.

Control theory Every human being tends to commit deviations because there is a vacuum of control or social control. Every individual in society has the same tendency to be "good" and "bad". Whether a person is good or bad depends on the society. This social control aims to prevent deviations and invite and direct people to behave in accordance with applicable norms. that there are two control contexts in criminology, namely internal and external control contexts, it appears that the containment theory put forward by Walter C. Reckless can also be used in analysis as a measure to prevent adultery. So for the scope of internal control, internal defense (inner containment) must be fulfilled by the individual, for example starting from good self-control and a high sense of responsibility. As for external control, it is a representation of external defense (outer containment) which includes:

1. Structural buffers in the environment that control behavior.
2. Institutional reinforcement of his norms, goals, & expectations.
3. Effective supervision and discipline social controls.
4. Strong group cohesion. The emphasis that needs to be given is that strong defenses (internal & external) are needed for individuals to be able to avoid or be prevented from committing adultery.

Internal control and external control must be carried out with both because it requires good control from oneself who as a creature of God Almighty is given advantages over other creatures, namely having thoughts and feelings of shame, so in fact the perpetrator of adultery has exceeded his limits as a creature of God. those who have a sense of shame, then for external control, in fact humans are social creatures who need other people in every part of their lives, reminding and reprimanding each other for bad actions committed, so there must be external control.

Apart from monitoring oneself and institutions, there is also other social control, namely the function of religion. Religious teachings will be subject to social supervision individually and in groups. According to Firganefi, lack of education and awareness of religious knowledge is a strong factor in someone committing a crime. A person who has low faith and in an environment with poor religious education does not have the self-control to commit a crime, because for him there is no loss in committing a crime but what he feels is always his own satisfaction which even harms other people, the mere thought of worldly satisfaction makes him forget. that the bad deeds he committed will have witnesses in the afterlife. Religion in an individual's life is of course the foundation or motivation in living their daily life. A person who is religious certainly has basic rules that come from his religion, especially regarding acts of adultery in the household.

Labeling theory or label factor is a theory that emerged as a result of society's reaction to someone's behavior that is considered deviant. Someone

who is considered deviant is then branded or labeled by their social environment. Howard S. Becker, studies of label theory emphasize two aspects, namely:

- a. Explains why and how certain people are labeled or labeled.
- b. The influence/effect of labels as a consequence of deviant behavior.

That one of the factors causing adultery is because men think that women are weak, so men can do anything including adultery because they think that women will not fight back and complain to the authorities if they find out about their man's adultery, for him women will obey all his orders, especially those that are beneficial to the man. with the crime of adultery, one of the factors is that the husband feels that in the family his position has a lot of power. This is of course related to patriarchal culture. Patriarchy comes from the word patriarchy, meaning a structure that places the role of men as the sole, central and everything ruler. The patriarchal system that dominates society's culture causes gender inequality and inequality that affects various aspects of human activities. problems caused by a system that does not run according to desires or expectations.

Various cases of adultery crimes cannot be separated from the persistence of patriarchal culture which is still embedded as a mindset and has become a causal factor. Patriarchal culture has the effect that men are stronger and more powerful than women, so that wives have limitations in making choices or desires and have a tendency to obey all their husbands' wishes, even bad ones. Patriarchal culture positions men as the strong ones and tends to have the freedom to do anything to women. This is what causes the high rate of adultery crimes.

Impact on Family Unity and Children's Future

The family is the foundation of society because the family plays an important role in children's early education and the growth of community life, integrity and harmony. The family is a reflection of a developed country. A happy family is the cornerstone of a strong country. The characteristics of a good family are understanding the goals, principles, requirements of marriage and building a household, readiness for marriage, family respect for each other, a sense of tolerance, supporting the family, and being able to maintain family harmony.

The fact is that there are still many families in Indonesia who do not understand and maintain the integrity of their families, this is proven by the widespread crime of adultery committed by both wives and husbands of these families. Of course, this greatly affects the unity of the family because the impact of adultery will be very widespread and have a long-term effect. The following are the bad impacts that will occur from the crime of adultery:

1. Impact on the Family

A harmonious family will collapse with adultery because from adultery there will be a divorce from a household, because the victim will feel unappreciated and unloved anymore so feeling disappointed and wanting to end the household is the best choice for him. It was recorded that there were

690 cases (0.15%) of divorce that occurred due to adultery in 2022. Of course, this number of cases is no longer small, therefore, adultery will make the family no longer harmonious and even divorce can occur due to the impact of the divorce. will also add to the negative impact.

2. Impact on the Child's Future

Children are part of the family who must be educated with a sense of security, comfort and happiness. Therefore, children really need a harmonious family to accompany their growth and development well, and a child's first environment is his family, the child's character will be formed according to his environment, if the environment is good then his character will also be good and vice versa if the child's environment is bad then his character will also be bad. Parents of children should create a good family environment for their child's development. However, in fact, there are still many family conditions that do not support children's growth and development, there are still many parents who do not think that everything they do will have a bad impact on their children.

Adultery is an act that has a big impact on the child, one of which is when the parents commit adultery and this will in fact result in divorce so that the child does not feel directly educated by his parents, the child will lose the role figure of his mother or father so that he will also feeling lonely and making children less enthusiastic about living life. Furthermore, if you find out that one of your parents has committed adultery, you will feel disappointed and the seeds of hatred will arise for the child towards his mother or father, because the relationship between parent and child should have a big influence on his life.

The trauma that occurs as a result of cases of adultery committed by the mother or father will make children avoid marriage when they grow up. They will feel reluctant to get married because they are afraid of experiencing the same thing as their parents. What's worse, they are even reluctant to have a relationship due to deep trauma.

Children whose parents have committed cases of adultery will experience behavioral problems. Their learning activities tend to no longer be controlled, which has an impact on their academic abilities, because this causes inner and mental pressure on the child which affects their enthusiasm for learning, therefore this has a big influence on the child's future.

These impacts are bad impacts that can hamper the progress of a country, especially Indonesia, therefore the government must find a solution to the crime of adultery. One of the efforts made by the government is through penal and non-penal measures.

The following will be attached the penal efforts that have been made by the government to prevent adultery by revising the regulations regarding adultery, namely as follows: Based on the results of the analysis, the difference lies in the addition of parties who have the right to complain and even if it is ultimately proven, there is an alternative sanction of a fine of no more than IDR 10 million. . The new Criminal Code regulates infidelity which is an act of adultery in Article 411 paragraph (1) and states that infidelity is every person who has sexual intercourse with someone who is not their husband or wife, being

punished for adultery. The new Criminal Code guarantees protection for victims. The protection given to the victim is the threat of criminal punishment for the suspect committing adultery, namely the threat of imprisonment for a maximum of 1 (one) year or a fine of up to category II. However, the new Criminal Code does not concretely regulate the guarantees obtained by victims of infidelity but only regulates legal protection in the form of applying criminal penalties to suspected perpetrators of infidelity.

Revising the Criminal Code regarding adultery has indeed become one way for the government to prevent adultery from occurring, but there must also be non-penal efforts to support preventing adultery from occurring in society, one of which is by closing places where adultery occurs, conducting raids, and providing direct outreach to the public regarding the negative impact of adultery.

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on the results and discussion that have been described, it can be concluded that the factors causing the crime of adultery are economic factors. Because the economy is one of the basic needs of a household, when the economy is not good there will be several impacts, one of which is infidelity which leads to adultery with another person. Apart from the perpetrator's economic social relations, the perpetrator was also not good, the perpetrator committed adultery with someone other than his husband or wife, of course this was caused by his unhealthy social circle. The crime of adultery also occurs because of the labeling of men who consider women to be servants for men so that patriarchal culture is still the cause of adultery.

Revising the Criminal Code regarding adultery has indeed become one of the government's penal efforts to prevent adultery from occurring, but there must also be non-penal efforts to support preventing adultery from occurring in society, one of which is by closing places where adultery occurs, conducting raids, and providing direct outreach to society regarding the negative impacts of adultery.

The negative impact on the integrity of the family and the future of their children is as follows: A harmonious family will collapse with adultery because from adultery there will be a divorce from a household, because the victim will feel unappreciated and unloved, resulting in feelings of disappointment and wanting to end it. his household is the best choice for him. The impact on children is that their learning activities tend to be uncontrolled, which has an impact on their academic abilities, because this causes inner and mental pressure on children which affects their enthusiasm for learning, therefore this has a big influence on the child's future.

FURTHER STUDY

Based on this research, there are still obstacles to obtaining data because this research uses criminological analysis which requires directly interviewing the perpetrator of adultery, but researchers still lack data regarding this matter. The suggestion for further research is that to research using criminological theory, you must interview the perpetrator directly.
